- 10:15 Tour of campus
- 11:00 Meet with staff and youth involved with SALT (Straight Ahead Leaders Tomorrow)
- 11:30 Lunch at culinary school on grounds at Lookout
- 12:15 Leave for return to church
- 12:30ish Back at Bear Valley

During these times you will get to see the school, housing units, staff areas, gym and auditorium. Tours will be led by one or two of the youth.
